

Policy: Fire Safety Requirements for Interior Finish Materials

- Paint or wall coverings not exceeding 1/28 inches in thickness and applied directly to a noncombustible substrate are exempt from these requirements.
- Floor covering such as carpeting, when used on walls or ceilings, shall meet the NFPA 255 Class A rating.
- Class A and B materials correlate directly to Class 1 and 2 materials as used in the Basic/National Building Code and the Uniform Building Code.
- 3.2 Interior floor finish in corridors and exits
 - Newly installed finishes shall be rated Class I in accordance0 Td(3e)4d(I)Tj0 (is)1 (h)2()TjE'
